*Margaret Downie McGuinness passed away on Wednesday, August 3 in the comfort of her home in Kyle, Texas, after a decades-long travail with carcinoid cancer. She was 78 at the time of her passing.*

*Born in Queens, New York on January 21, 1944, Margaret was the youngest child and only daughter to Thomas Murray and Mary Jessie (Downie) Campbell. She grew up in Maspeth, Queens, New York, and graduated from Grover Cleveland High School. She enjoyed spending her summers as a teenager in Newport, Rhode Island, with her extended family. She began work at the Equitable Life Assurance Society, where she met her future husband, Richard L. McGuinness. The two were wed on June 13, 1964. Margaret and Richard began their family in Queens, and eventually purchased their first home out on Long Island, in Medford, New York. The couple eventually moved to Williston Park, New York, and later relocated to Kyle, Texas. Known as Maggie to her friends, she enjoyed social activities such as Bunco with her friends from the Kyle United Methodist Church and the First Baptist Church of Kyle. She was also an active grandmother who enjoyed doting on her grandchildren.*

*Margaret was preceded in death by her parents, Thomas and Mary Campbell; her eldest brother, Reverend David Campbell; and dear sister-in-law, Norma Hickey.*

*She is survived by her husband of 58 years, Richard L. McGuinness; their children, Richard D.
